

# WILDFLOWERS!

Come to Edgewood Natural Preserve for a free docent-led wildflower walk.

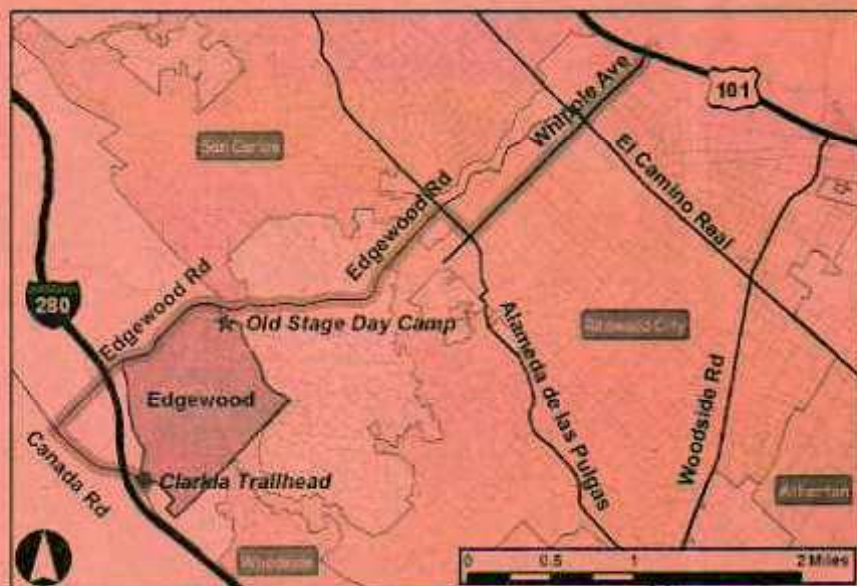
Every Saturday and Sunday from March 10 to June 10, 2007.  
Walks begin at 10:00 AM and end around 1:00 PM.

Edgewood's serpentine grasslands are renowned throughout California for their lush wildflower carpets and rich biodiversity. You might see dozens of species of flowers on a single walk! Our walks vary according to what's in bloom—covering about 3 miles, at a moderate pace, with frequent stops.



Bring water, a hat, and sunscreen, and a snack if you wish. Restrooms and water are available only at the Old Stage Day Camp. No reservations are needed.

Walks start from the **Old Stage Day Camp** every weekend throughout the season.
